Chuck was also the Chairman of the Republican Party of Iowa from 2001–2005. He is a Major in the U.S. Army Reserves. He served for a year in Iraq, from 2004–2005, where he was awarded the Bronze Star for meritorious service in combat and the Combat Action badge. While there, he spearheaded the collection and distribution of \$100,000 in school and medical supplies to the Iraqis. They also built 12 new

schools and three water filtration sanitation systems providing clean water to the community for the first time.
