

1. Abortion & Right to Life

1.1	We support the reversal of Roe v. Wade, thus criminalizing abortion.	
1.2	We support legislation requiring consent by a parent and/or legal guardian before a minor child or ward receives an abortion or any other reproductive services or products.	
1.3	We support a “Woman’s Right to Know Law” whereby performers of abortions must provide complete factual information to the pregnant woman about the complications of abortion, the biological development of the unborn, fetal pain, and availability of alternatives to abortion.	
1.4	We oppose using public revenues at any level of government to fund abortions or organizations, such as Planned Parenthood, which advocate abortion.	
1.5	We oppose euthanasia, assisted suicide, and non-consensual withholding of treatment due to age, disability, or infirmity.	
1.6	We support the unalienable personhood of every American, from the moment of conception until natural death.	
1.7	We support the abolition of tele-med abortions.

3.1	We support reducing excessive regulation of business.

4. Education

4.1	We support the abolition of the U.S. Department of Education with return of educational support and monitoring of all levels of education to the individual states.	
4.2	We support tax credits to parents of children educated in non-public schools and home schooling environments.	
4.3	We support local control of all public school affairs.	
4.4	We support parental rights legislation that specifically affirms the right of a parent to direct the education and upbringing of a minor child.	
4.5	We support presenting all scientific evidence for intelligent design in our government funded schools.	
4.6	We oppose the Common Core Curriculum, as well as any curriculum that originates by an act of congress or rule mandated by the Federal Department of Education.	
4.7	We oppose the collection and sharing of personal student data for non-educational purposes without prior written consent of an adult student or a minor child's parent.	
4.8	We oppose ratification of the "so called" United Nations Convention of the Child, which interferes with a parent's right to direct the education and upbringing of their children.

5.1	We support finding ways to eliminate wasteful spending within the Iowa Department of Transportation before considering raising the gas tax.

6. Family Values

6.1	We support a constitutional amendment defining marriage as the union between one man and one woman and believe that the traditional family is the building block to a moral, healthy, and thriving society.	
6.2	We support non-familial adoption by heterosexual married couples consisting of one man and one woman, and believe that no law should infringe on faith-based adoptive service agencies that offer their services in accordance with their beliefs.	
6.3	We support improving, strengthening, and simplifying the adoption process so that more children can have a father and mother.	
6.4	We support efforts to reduce the number of divorces and harmful custody battles.	

7. Government

7.1	We believe that the federal government should be strictly limited to the 18 enumerated powers in the United States Constitution and that all others should be left to the states and to the people in accordance with the 10 th Amendment.	
7.2	We support legislation to protect Iowa's state sovereignty, in order to restore the proper relationship between the State of Iowa and the federal government, as defined by the 10 th Amendment to the Constitution of the United States.	
7.3	We support requiring candidates for State and Federal offices in the State of Iowa to file proof of their eligibility for office with the Secretary of State.	
7.4	We support applying term limits to all elective offices so that no individual would serve more than 12 continuous years in any given elective position.	
7.5	We believe that for any law passed by Congress and signed by the President should apply equally to all citizens, including Congress, the President, their families and staff, with no exceptions.	
7.6	We believe English should be the official language of the United States and that all official documents be printed in English.	
7.7	We support requiring Iowa citizens to present accepted State of Iowa identification in order to cast a ballot or to request an absentee ballot.	
7.8	We support holding government agencies and officials accountable by reducing funding or termination for targeting individuals and groups that oppose them politically.	
7.9	We support providing monetary benefits to retired elected federal officials at no more than three times the amount provided to the lowest benefited retired federal employee and all other provided benefits equal to the amount of that employee.	

8. Health & Human Services

8.1	We support the repeal of the Affordable Care Act.	
8.2	We support the random drug screening for federal and Iowa State welfare recipients.	
8.3	We oppose providing state or federal benefits to illegal aliens.	
8.4	We oppose providing Federal and Iowa State welfare and social security benefits to illegal aliens.	
8.5	We oppose the inclusion of federal food assistance funding in the agriculture budget.	

9. Homeland Security & Immigration

9.1	We oppose the wholesale warrantless collection of U.S. citizen's internet, telephone, banking, and library activity, also the collection of a person's auto license plate information, travel information, and vehicle, facial, or body images, along with any other personal biometric data by the National Security Agency and all other U.S. federal intelligence agencies.	
9.2	We support the repeal of the Patriot Act.	
9.3	We oppose the indefinite detention of American citizens on American and foreign soil by members of the Armed Forces of the United States.	
9.4	We support citizenship for a child born in the United States based on the United States citizenship of the child's parents, and that the 14 th Amendment does not provide automatic citizenship to the children of non-citizens.	
9.5	We support expansion of the worker-visa program to allow legal immigrants to work in the United States.	
9.6	We support vigorous federal enforcement of all laws related to securing the borders and enforcing the legal immigration process.	
9.7	We oppose amnesty for illegal immigrants.	

10. Law & Justice

10.1	We oppose the legalization of marijuana products for the purpose of medical and personal consumption.	
10.2	We support the adoption of the following amendment to the Iowa Constitution: "The right of an individual to acquire, keep, possess, transport, carry, transfer, and use arms to defend life and liberty without retreating, and for all other legitimate purposes is fundamental and shall not be infringed upon or denied. Mandatory licensing, registration, or special taxation as a condition of the exercise of this right is prohibited, and any other restriction shall be subject to strict scrutiny."	
10.3	We support the concealed carry of a firearm on Iowa college campuses	
10.4	We support the Firearms Freedom Act in Iowa, protecting any firearm that is manufactured in Iowa, sold in Iowa, that stays in Iowa from being subjected to any federal regulations.	
10.5	We oppose any firearms and ammunition laws and regulations imposed on the citizens of the State of Iowa by the federal government.	
10.6	We oppose the use of Tasers against persons that have been subdued by law enforcement officers and those officers should receive adequate training in the use of Tasers before an officer is permitted to use and or is issued a Taser.	
10.7	We support legislation which allows unrestrained freedom of speech, including public prayer and the pledge of allegiance.	
10.8	We oppose predatory and abusive lending practices and call for passage and vigorous enforcement of laws against it.	
10.9	We support the abolition of human trafficking.	

11. National Defense & Foreign Policy

11.1	We support the highest ethical standards in the treatment of captured enemy combatants while being detained, and oppose the use of torture.	
11.2	We support legislation that reverses the denial or reduction of promised benefits at the time of enlistment for our veterans and current active duty personnel.	
11.3	We support the conversion of vacant military bases into housing, centers for recovery and retraining of homeless veterans, accompanied by their immediate families if necessary.	
11.4	We support adequate national defense funding to defend our nation.	
11.5	We support Israel's right to defend itself and we should refrain from pressuring Israel to forfeit land for peace.	
11.6	We support the repair of traditional international alliances.	
11.7	We support Israel in their natural and God-given right of self-governance and self-defense upon their own lands, recognizing that Israel is neither an attacking force nor an occupier of the lands of others: and that peace can be afforded the region only through a united Israel governed under one law for all people.	
11.8	We oppose efforts to capitulate to Iran's nuclear capabilities.	
11.9	We oppose foreign aid to enemy countries.

12.1	We support the Environmental Protection Agency being subject to the will of Congress.

13. Taxes & Spending

13.1	We support a Federal Balanced Budget Amendment and believe that the State of Iowa and the Federal Government should maintain a balanced budget by controlling spending and that the national debt should be reduced and ultimately paid in full.	
13.2	We support the repeal of the 16 th Amendment of the Constitution of the United States and the elimination of the Internal Revenue Service, replacing it with a national Fair Tax	
13.3	We support the establishment of a flat tax or a combination sales and flat tax to eliminate the federal Internal Revenue Service.	
13.4	We support a full and complete audit of the Federal Reserve.	
13.5	We support ending the Federal Reserve system.	
13.6	We support further welfare reforms, including drug testing for welfare recipients.	
13.7	We believe that County, State, and Federal budgets must be balanced, including past, present, and future expenditures except for declared states of emergency or war.	
13.8	We support the repeal of the Iowa income tax.	
13.9	We support the deduction of all federal income tax payments on their Iowa income tax returns.	
13.10	We support the elimination of one trillion dollars from the federal budget in real cuts.	
13.11	We support an Iowa Constitutional Amendment that will require approval by majority vote of the people for any increase of state taxes or fees that exceeds one percent of annual state general fund revenue.	
13.12	We support an Iowa Constitutional Amendment that will limit state general fund spending to no more than 99% of estimated revenue, require a 60% vote of both houses of the Legislature to spend any of the state's reserve funds, and require the state to follow generally accepted accounting principles.	
13.13	We support limited Federal and Iowa State government spending, reduction of debt and waste, and the elimination of attachment appropriations to non-appropriation bills.	

14. Republican Party

14.1	We support the cessation of hostilities towards the Tea Party, Tea Party and conservative candidates, and their conservative supporters by Republicans from within all levels of the party.	
14.2	We support a Republican party that epitomizes openness and transparency.	
14.3	We support the adoption of rules requiring candidates for State Central Committee and all other Republican Party of Iowa offices to submit their nominations and make their intentions clear two weeks prior to any convention at which they stand for election.	
14.4	We support the right of Iowans to speak freely and to practice religious freedoms as guaranteed to citizens under the First Amendment to the United States Constitution.	
14.5	We support every citizen's constitutional right to pray, read the bible or any religious text, display the ten commandments, and other expressions of faith and doctrine in private and in public, including public schools of this state.
